Canada Day

Today, on July 1, Canadians from coast to coast will be taking part in Canada Day celebrations. We praise God for the diversity, freedom and achievements of our country. We are also grateful that our nation has welcomed thousands of refugees who can now call Canada home. As we commemorate this special day, pray that Canada would continue to work towards reconciliation with our Indigenous peoples – who first welcomed us here to “Turtle Island”. Please pray that Canada would also advocate for peace and justice in our world. May God grant wisdom and understanding to our leaders in government, as they make decisions that affect the well-being of Canadians and others around the world. Also, we pray that Baptist churches in Canada would be strengthened as they strive to be the hands and feet of Jesus within their communities.

Bible Translation in Cameroon

CBM Strategic Associates Dan and Melody Grove work with Wycliffe Bible Translators in Cameroon. The Groves have been working with a team that consists of both international missionaries and local members to develop literacy programs and translate the New Testament into each local language. The Groves recently shared the following prayer requests:

- Pray for the preparation of the Chrambo New Testament for typesetting. This involves a lot of reading through the text.

- Pray for the Bamunka New Testament translation, so the local community can access the “Luke” film in their language.
- Pray that the translated Scriptures will go out in each of the villages and that lives will be changed as people come to know God.
- Pray for safety for us and those with whom we work.
- Pray for our children, Caleb and Courtney, who are returning to Canada.

Eagle’s Wings Project

Alas de Águila (Eagle’s Wings) is a new CBM project in Bolivia that provides support to mothers whose children attend Casa de la Amistad. These children have a parent living in prison and go to Casa de la Amistad for meals, tutoring support, counselling and a safe place to play. Due to the challenging circumstances faced by these families, the mothers often struggle to provide for their children. Through Eagle’s Wings, which launched earlier this year, these mothers can now benefit from sewing training and life skills workshops. In partnership with local social workers, the mothers learn parenting techniques, communications skills and how to address domestic violence. Please pray for the mothers as they seek to rebuild their lives and earn a living to support their families. Pray that their children would also feel safe, secure and loved. May God answer their prayers and provide for their every need – both physically and spiritually.
