SHORT-TERM MISSIONS

Logos Baptist Church in Mississauga, ON, left for a CBM short-term mission trip to Germany on Thursday and will return on October 9. The four-member team will be working alongside local churches to minister to the large number of students from mainland China studying in German universities. Scarborough Chinese Baptist Church also sent a team to Germany on Friday, and will return on October 16. VULNERABLE CHILDREN IN DRC

In partnership with the Baptist Community in Central Africa (CBCA), CBM helps to support children with disabilities in the Democratic Republic of Congo. Please pray for our Social Support for Vulnerable Children program, which provides vocational living with physical and mental disabilities, as well as youth living with post-conflict trauma. Through the program, they learn income-generating skills such as sewing, shoemaking, hairdressing and gardening. They also receive basic literacy training and emotional and social support. We are

Please pray that they would experience God's love through the support of this ministry, and that God would work within their communities to break down the barriers that lead to stigma and discrimination.
